Our Camping Supply List serves as a base list to help you prepare for troop outings, but it is not exhaustive. Depending on the trip, weather conditions, and specific activities planned, additional gear may be required.

We recommend reviewing the event details and checking with troop leadership before each campout to ensure you have all necessary equipment. If you're unsure about any items, feel free to ask for guidance!

Sleeping and Storage

Waterproof Tent
Waterproof Tarp - for use under the tent if the tent does not have a reinforced base
Sleeping Bag - rated for current weather conditions
Sleeping Pad or Foam Mat
Small Pillow
Lightweight Blanket - optional for extra warmth
Clothing
TSG Uniform - for formal events
Moisture-Wicking Base Layers
Insulating Mid-Layers - fleece, wool, etc
Waterproof and/or Windproof Jacket
Extra Socks and Underwear





Camping and Survival Gear

Pocket Knife or Multi-Tool
Compass and Map - if applicable
Headlamp or Flashlight - with extra batteries
Fire-Starting Kit - waterproof matches, lighter, fire starter
Paracord or Small Rope
Cooking and Eating Gear
Mess Kit - bowl, plate, utensils
Insulated Water Bottle or Hydration Pack
Lightweight Cup or Mug
Personal Cooler with Snacks and Drinks
Personal Hygiene and First Aid

Sunscreen and Lip Balm
